



Sen. Lamar Alexander (R-TN)



Sen. Lamar Alexander is a 3rd term Senator in the US Congress who represents Tennessee and received 61.9% of the vote in his last election. He is the Chair of the HELP committee, and a member of the Senate Rules, Appropriations, and Energy committees.

He works most frequently on Education (48 bills), Health (46 bills), Economics and Public Finance (46 bills), Science, Technology, Communications (39 bills), and Intergovernmental relations (38 bills). He has sponsored 169 bills in his last sixteen year(s) in office, voting with his party 86.4% of the time, getting 23.67% of his bills out of committee, and 5.92% of his sponsored bills enacted.

Sen. Alexander most frequently cosponsors Johnny Isakson (R-GA) (25 bills), Mike Enzi (R-WY) (24 bills), and Richard Burr (R-NC) (22 bills). He most frequently votes with Roger Wicker (R-MS) (87.22%), Rob Portman (R-OH) (86.82%), and John Boozman (R-AR) (86.61%).

Before entering politics, Sen. Alexander was involved in education. He received his undergraduate degree from Vanderbilt University (TN) and a professional degree from New York University Law School.

Log Your Meeting Electronically

We are making it easier to log your notes from your lobby visits directly into the software we use to compile notes on members of Congress. These visits are key to ongoing relations with elected representatives and inform our interactions going forward.



Here's how:

1. Open your Camera App on your smartphone.
2. Point the camera steady for 2-3 seconds toward the QR code.
3. A link will appear that directs you to the website: ibew.quorum.us/log
4. Input your information in the necessary fields to create your account.
5. Log your briefing notes from your meeting. Please ensure to include as much information as possible regarding your interaction.
6. Repeat these steps for each meeting.
